

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How to use this book: A guide for family members

LEVEL 4

This book is a Read@Home book, designed for your child to read and enjoy at home. Read@Home books come in 4 levels:

| Book level | Type of reader |
|------------|--|
| 1 | Pre-reader |
| 2 | Early reader |
| 3 | Independent reader who still needs some help |
| 4 | Independent reader |

This book is LEVEL 4: Independent reader.

The best way to use this book is to encourage your child to read it out loud to you. Help the child sound out and understand any word that he or she does not know. At the beginning, talk to the child about what the book might be about. At the end of the book, ask the child to talk about the story. Ask the child questions like, “What would you do if you were a character in this story?” and “What do you think will happen next?” and “How do you think she (main character) should solve this problem?” The child should then read and enjoy the book as often as he or she wishes.
