

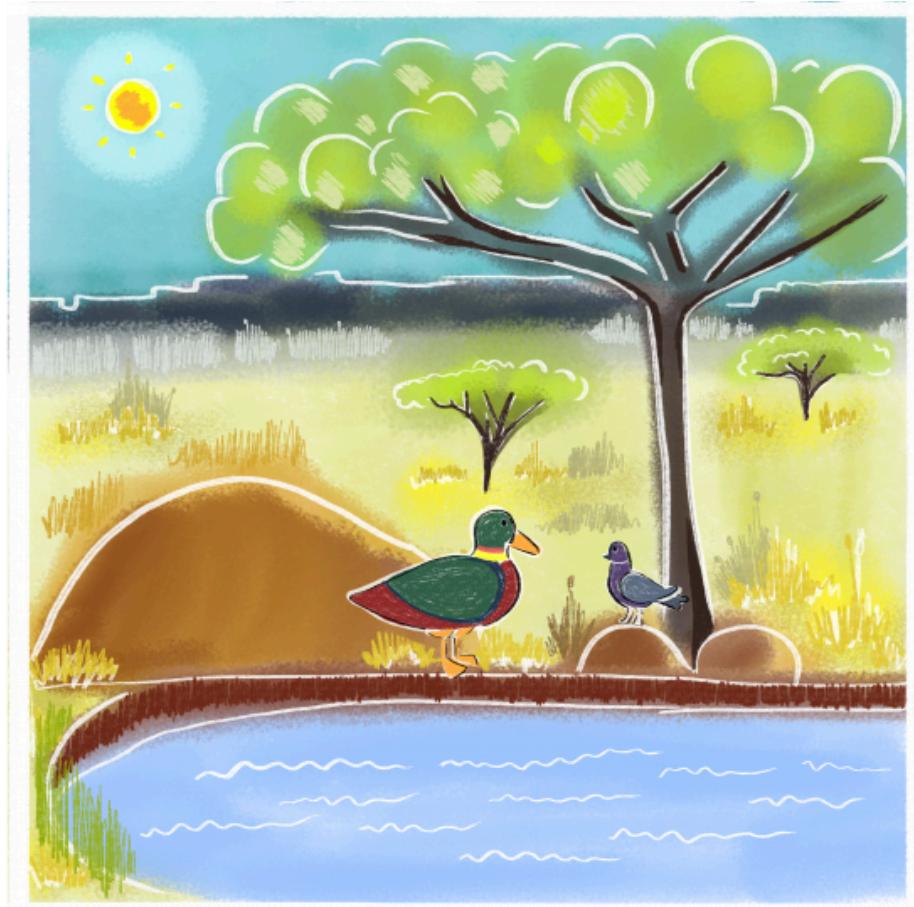


UDada noHobe

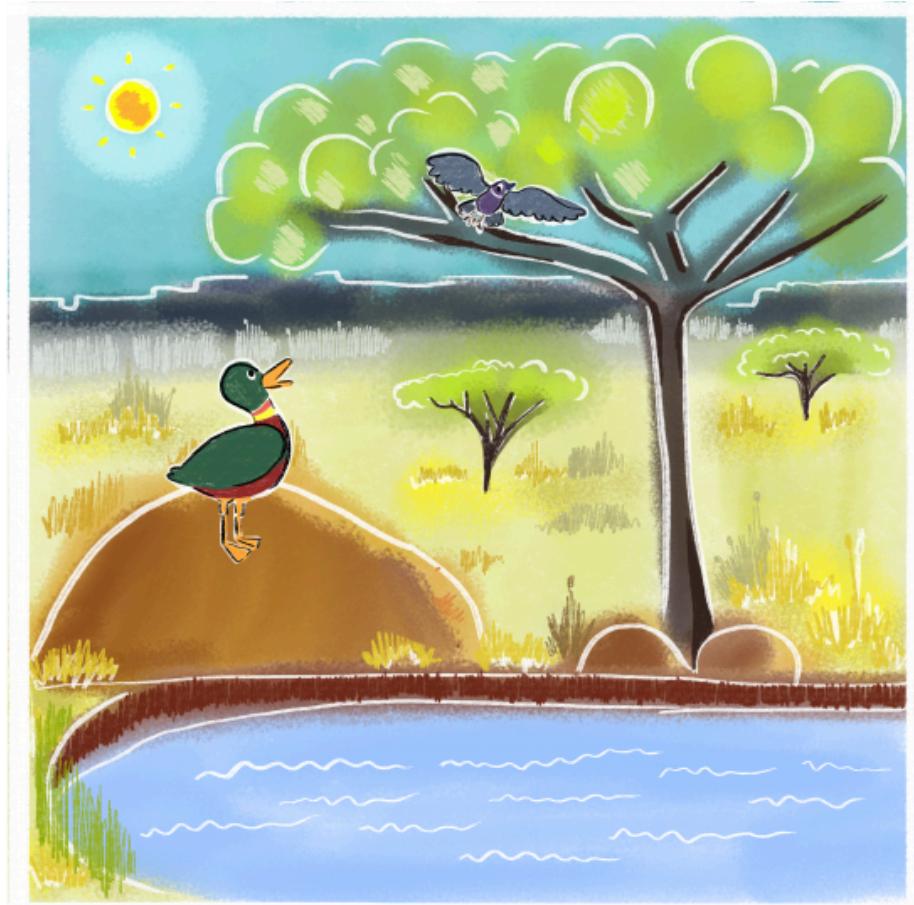
“Ndoyika ukurhaxwa,” waphendula uHobe.
