

Nia's pet chameleon likes to hide, which makes it very hard to find. What should I do? Nia wonders. Then, she has an idea!









On Monday, she decides to color her chameleon red. This will help her find it easily.

When my pet is a bright color, thinks Nia, I will find it easily.






"Look, I'm here!"

On Thursday, she decides to color it green.









Can you see where Nia's pet has hidden itself?




On Friday, she colors it blue.




Nia's pet hides on a painting hanging on the wall.






The chameleon hides on a plate of grapes.
