He managed to eat

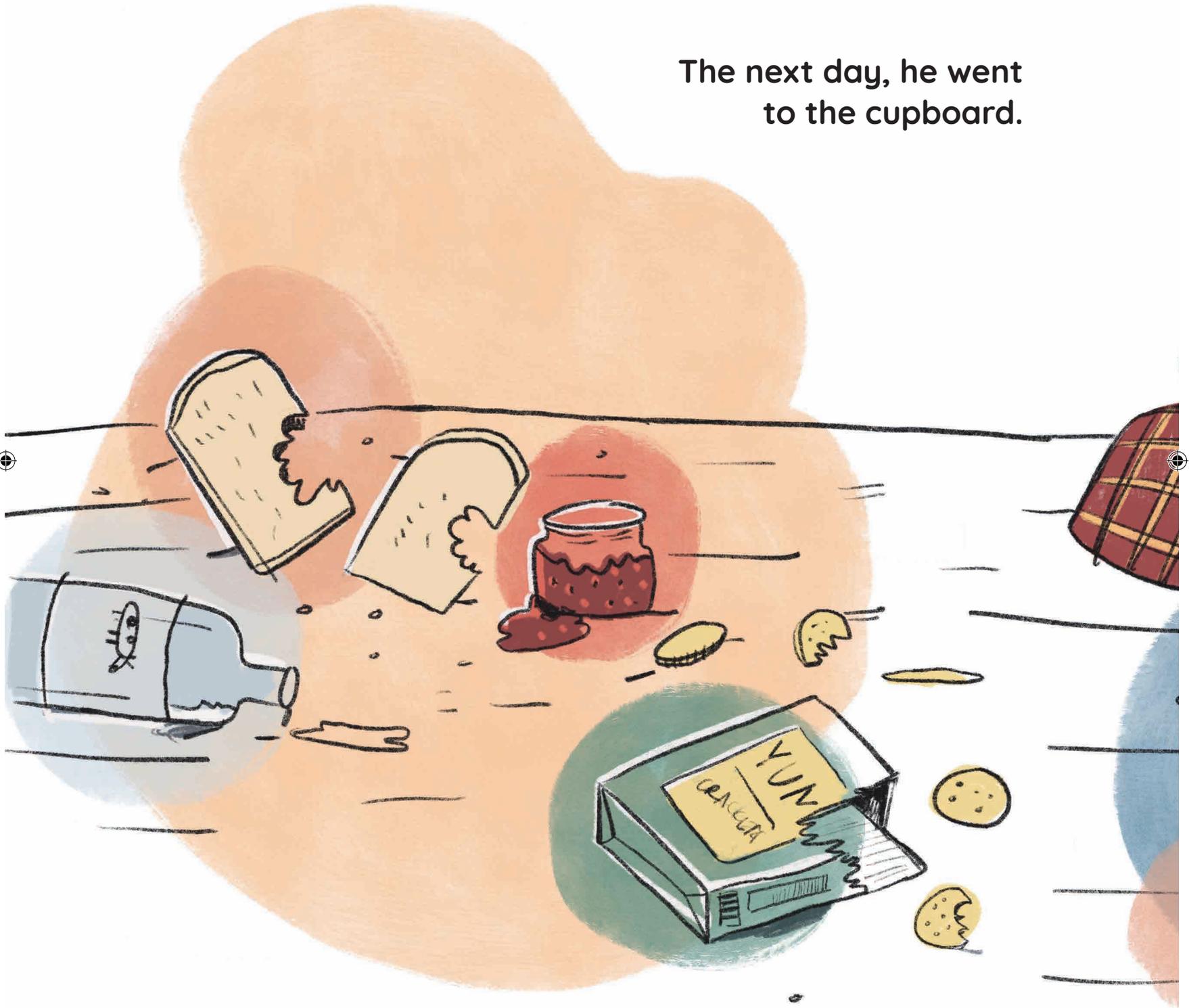
them **ALL**.

Tommy wanted more to eat!



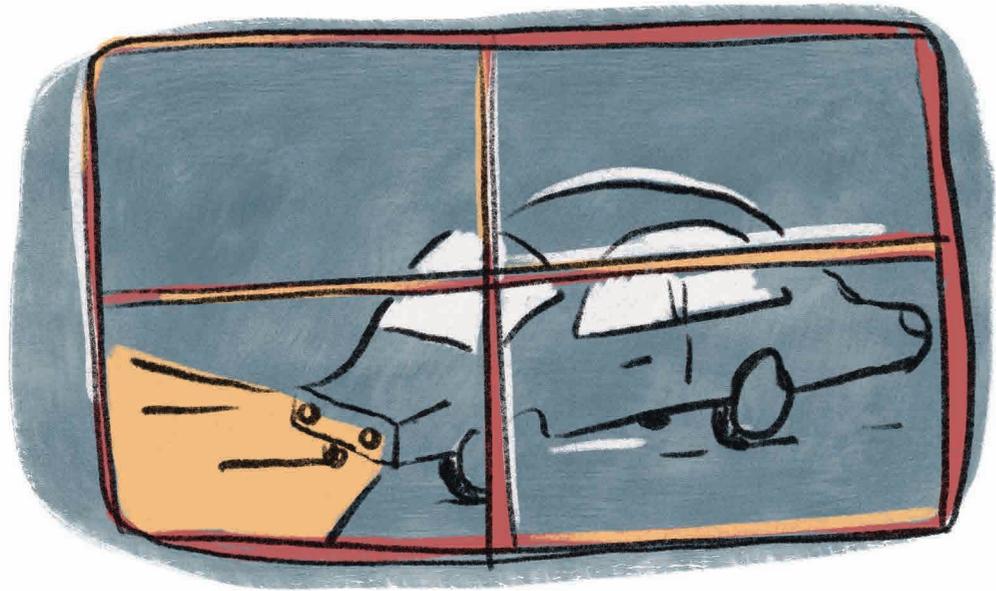


Tommy ate

in the refrigerator.







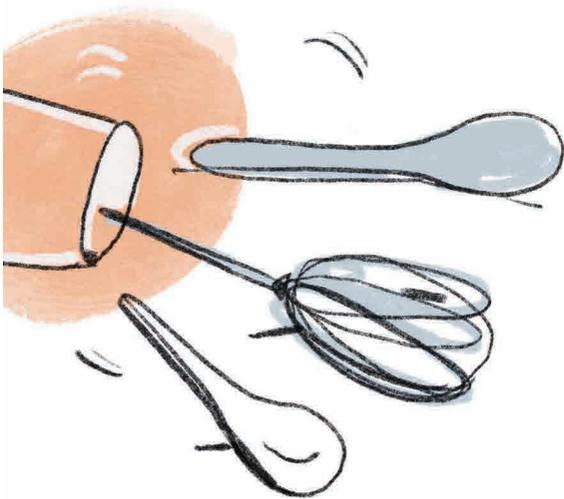


One morning,

girl saw Tommy.**

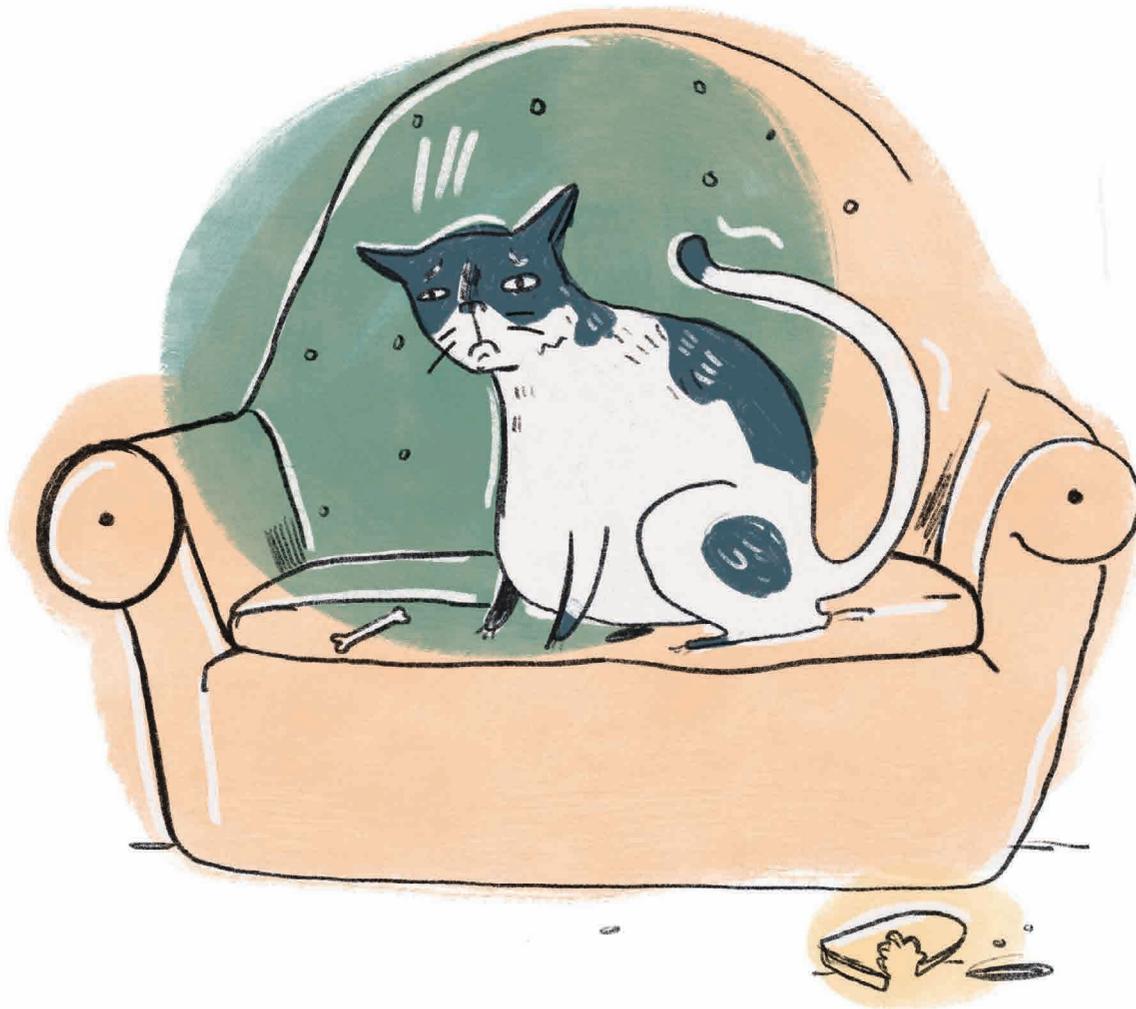
**“It wasn’t thieves!
