





My name is Maddy Moona.

I know just what to get!








I'm going to get an elephant.

He'll think I'm super cool.






But... what if Ellie caught a cold?

and fish and chips, and ice-cream too.






I'll keep him in the bathtub

Teacups crashing! Smashing plates!


I'd clean up till I'm ten!
