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






What's in the Pot?

on the stove.








She added a jug of **water**.

replied Mama.






“Can I **help?**” asked Sam. “I could **stir.**”

said Mama.


“The **pot** might fall over.

by **fetching** things.”






“Can you bring me an **onion**, please.”

They are **round** and **brown**.”






“Is **supper** ready yet?”




“If you are hungry you can

“What’s in the **pot**?”






“It’s a **surprise.** Wait and see.”

for the pot.”






“See if you can find some **spinach**.
It is also **green**.”






“Please get some **bread.**”






No, it won't go into the **pot**
