






“Tjiyo! Tjiyo! Tjiyo!”

“Kufanele kutsi kumnandzi kubhukusha.”


Nakacedza kufaka inhloko yakhe emantini,

Vukutfu wacabanga aphantseke kabi, “Ngeke sekwenteke ngikwati kubhukusha njengaDada.”


Dada wasala yedvwa emantini.

Vukutfu waphendvula watsi, “Ngesaba kuncwila.”


“Bengitsi ufuna kufundza kubhukusha njengami,” kusho Dada.

Vukutfu waya edwaleni lelikhulu. Dada walandzela.


Masinyane, Vukutfu besekasetulu esihlahleni lesidze. Dada wehluleka kumlandzela.

kubhukusha hhayi kundiza.”


Vukutfu bekafuna kudvudvuta umngani wakhe.
