

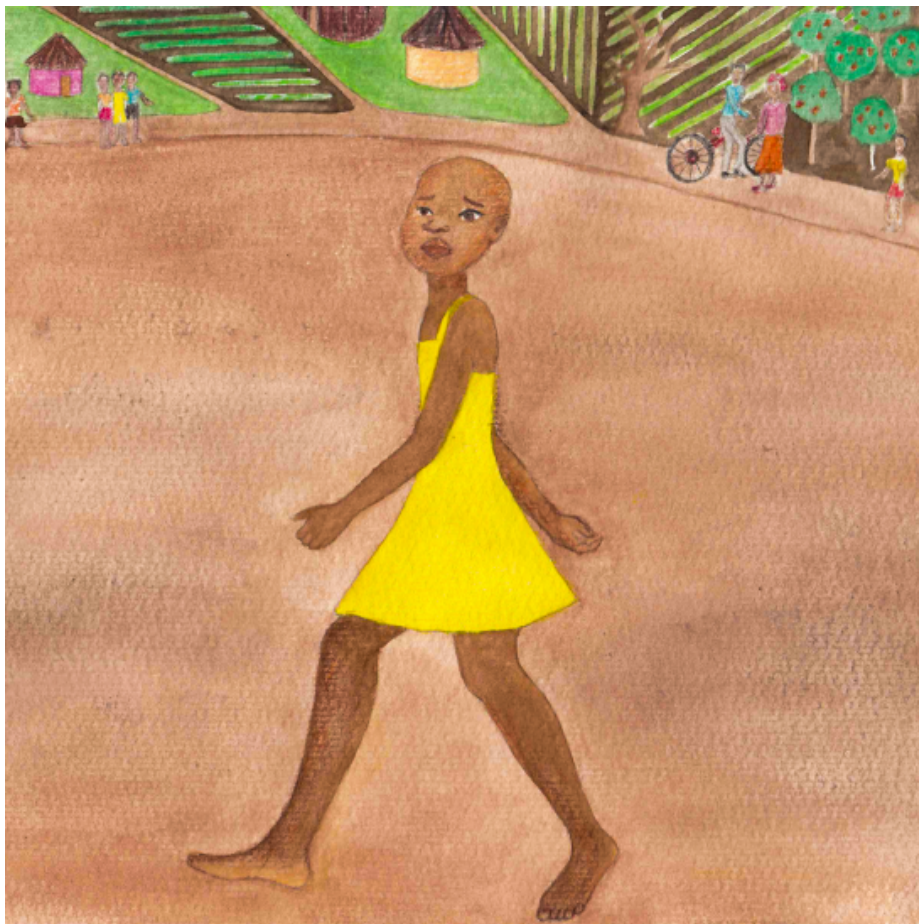

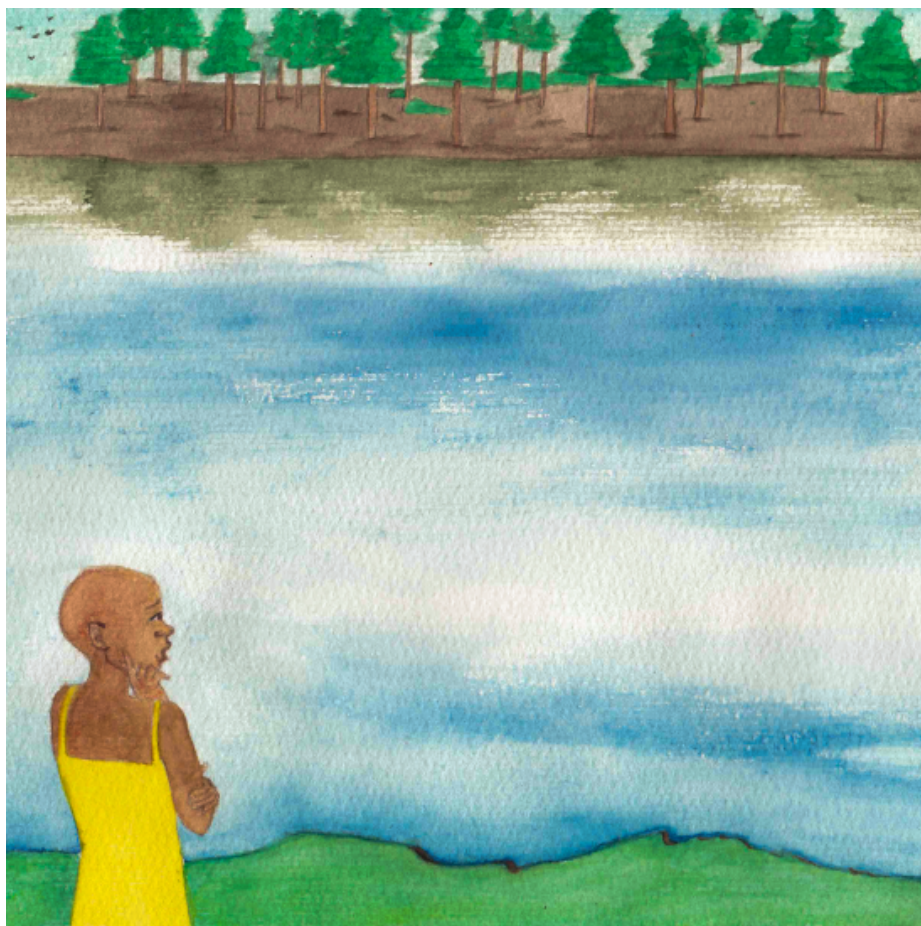
Ka mehla ge a opela, moriri o khupetša sefahlego sa gagwe.

O kgona go kwa le go dupelela kotsi ge e etla.

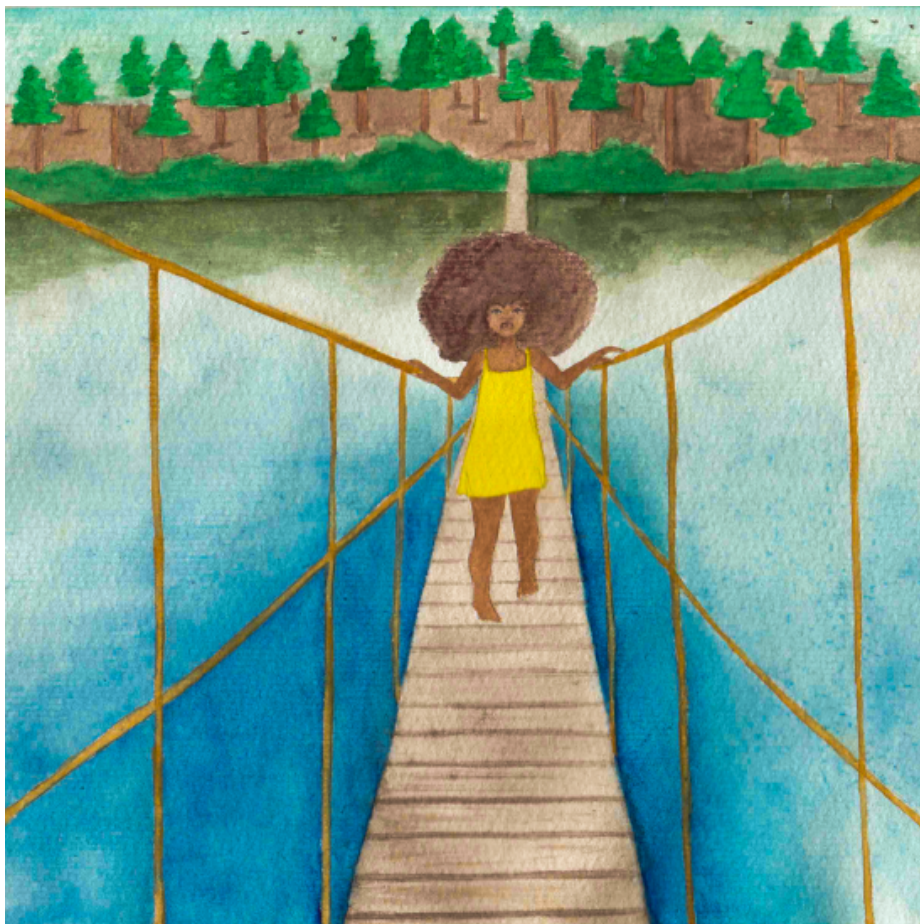
O kgona go tseba ge motho a etla go yena ka

Gateetee, gwa tšwelela leporogo.

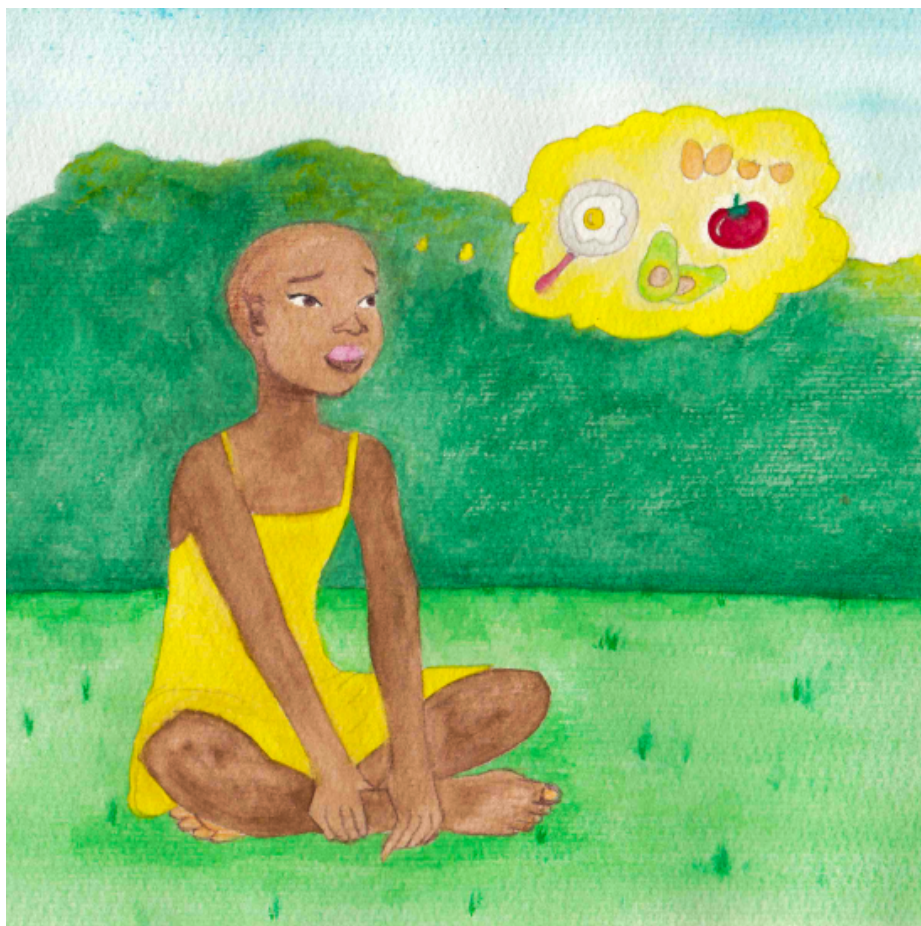
A re go tšhelela ka mošola wa noka a tšwela pele ka leeto la gagwe. A sepelela kgole le sethokgwa se a se tsebago.

A goeletša a re, "Maatla! Maatla!"

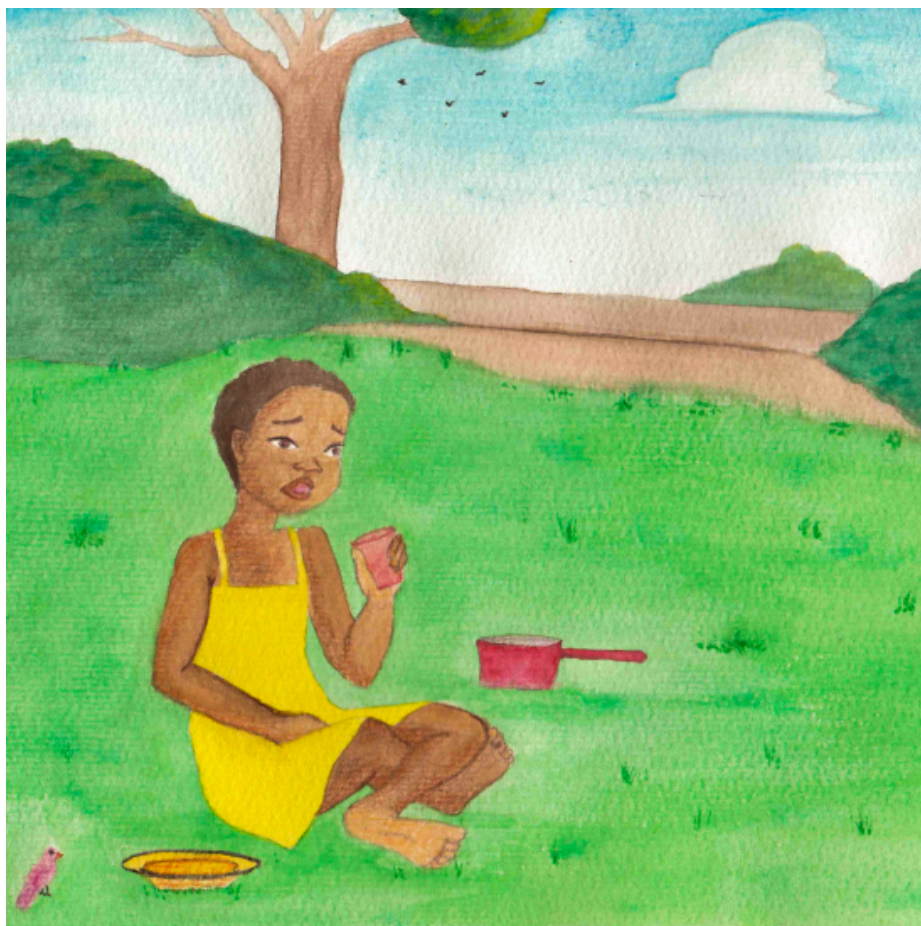
Gateetee, bjang bja tšwelela go mo dikologa. A

A itatswa melomo a goeletša a re, “Maatla! Maatla!”

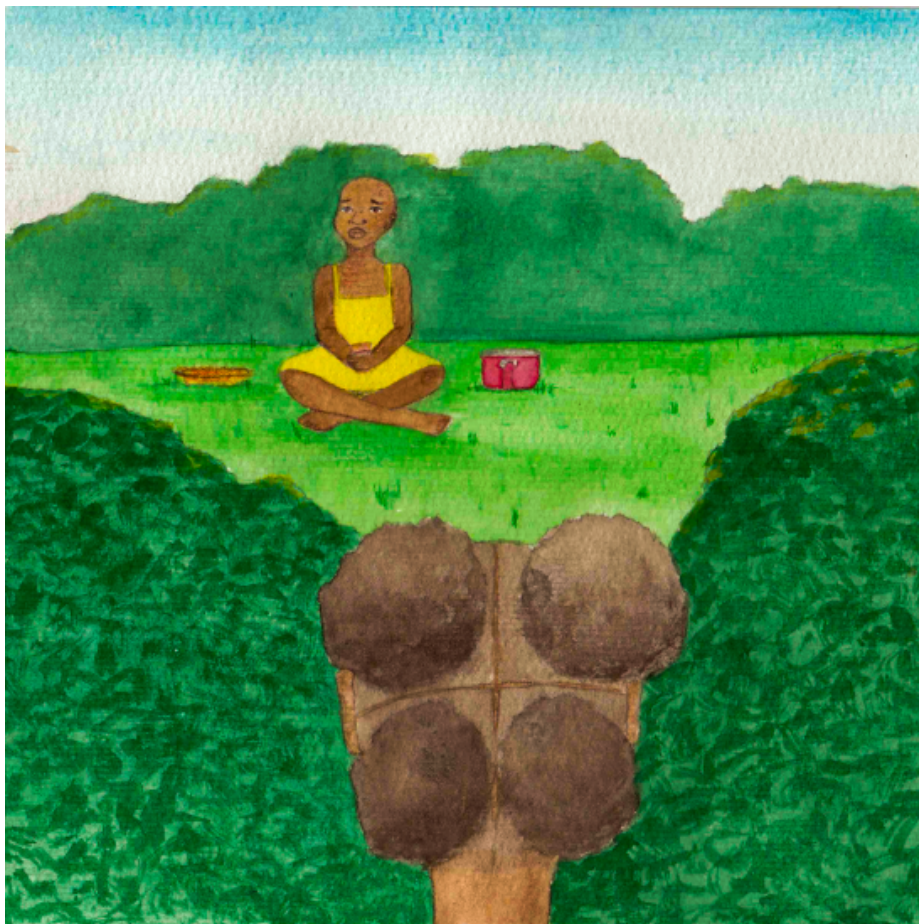
Gateetee, gwa tšwelela dipitša di se na selo, dibjana le dikomiki.
