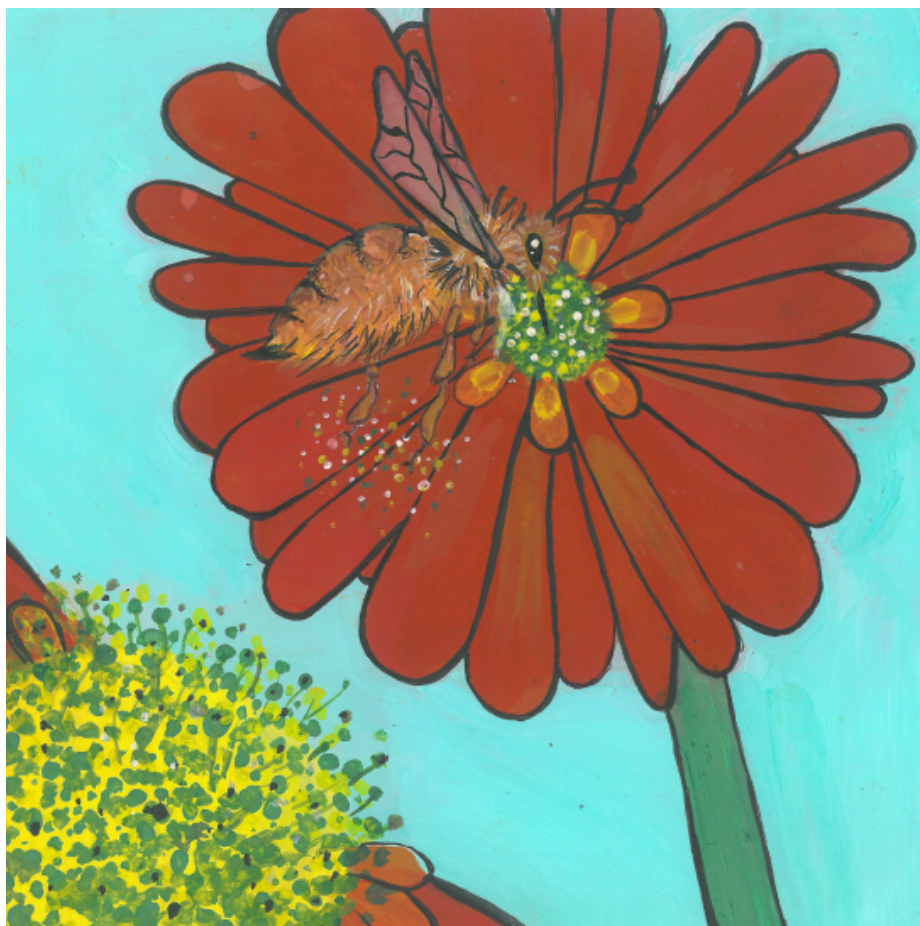
Lereko wabuta make wabo, “Luchamuka kuphi luju?”
