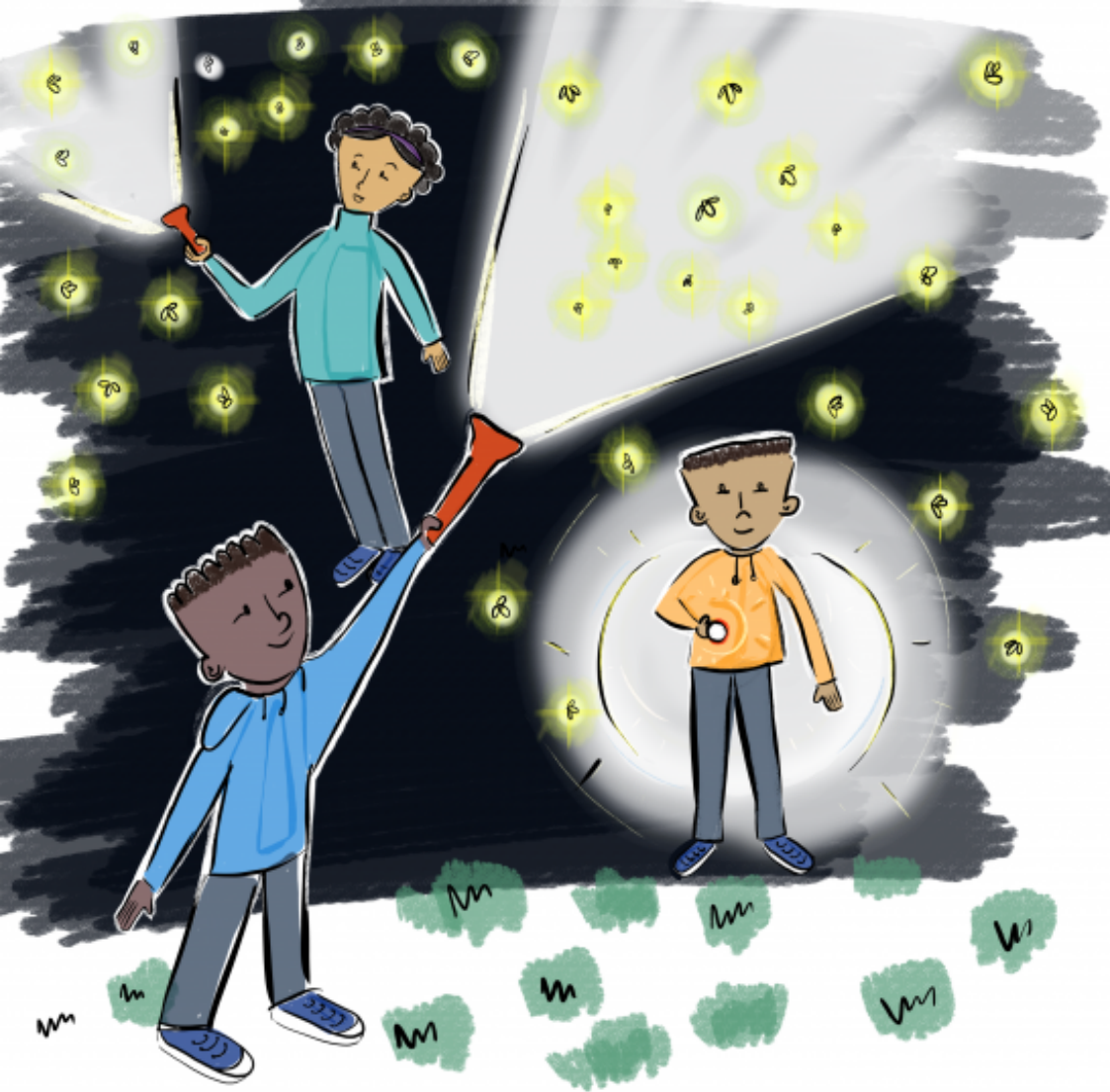




UTito nokhanyikhanyi

“Zibizwa ngokuthini zona lezi zinambuzane?” kubuza uSizwe ebuka phakathi ebhodleleni.

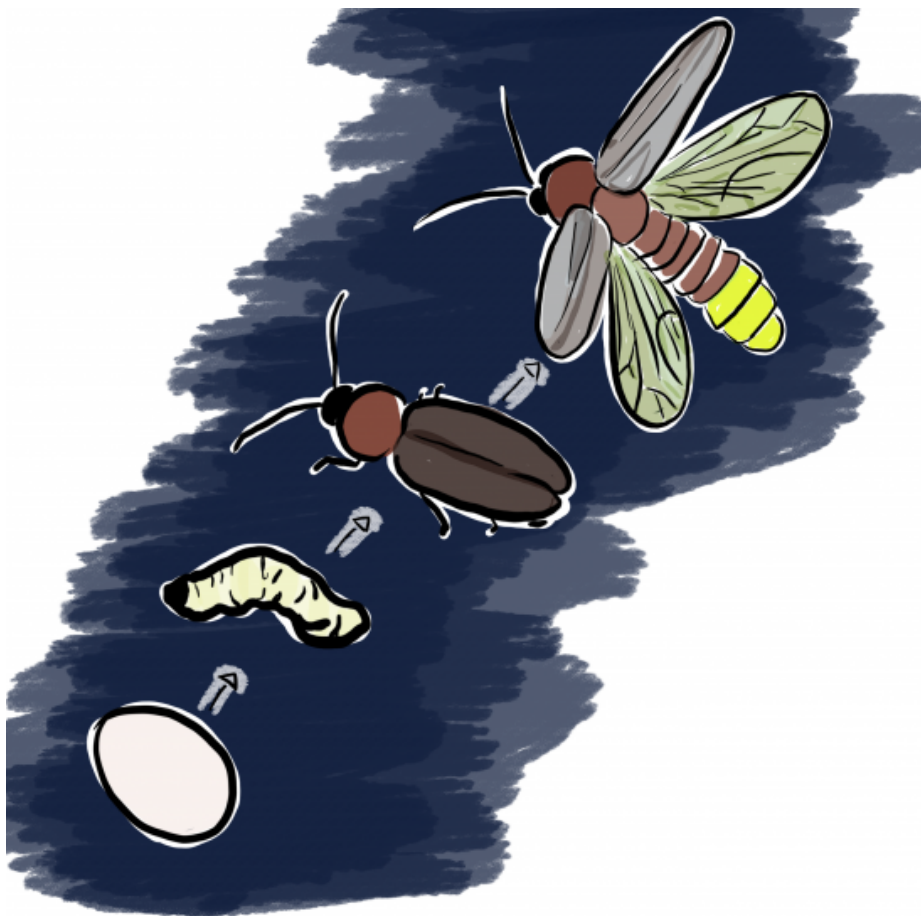
“Zikwenza kanjani ukukhanya?” kubuza uTito.

“Ngifunda ngokhanyikhanyi esikoleni,” eqhubeka.

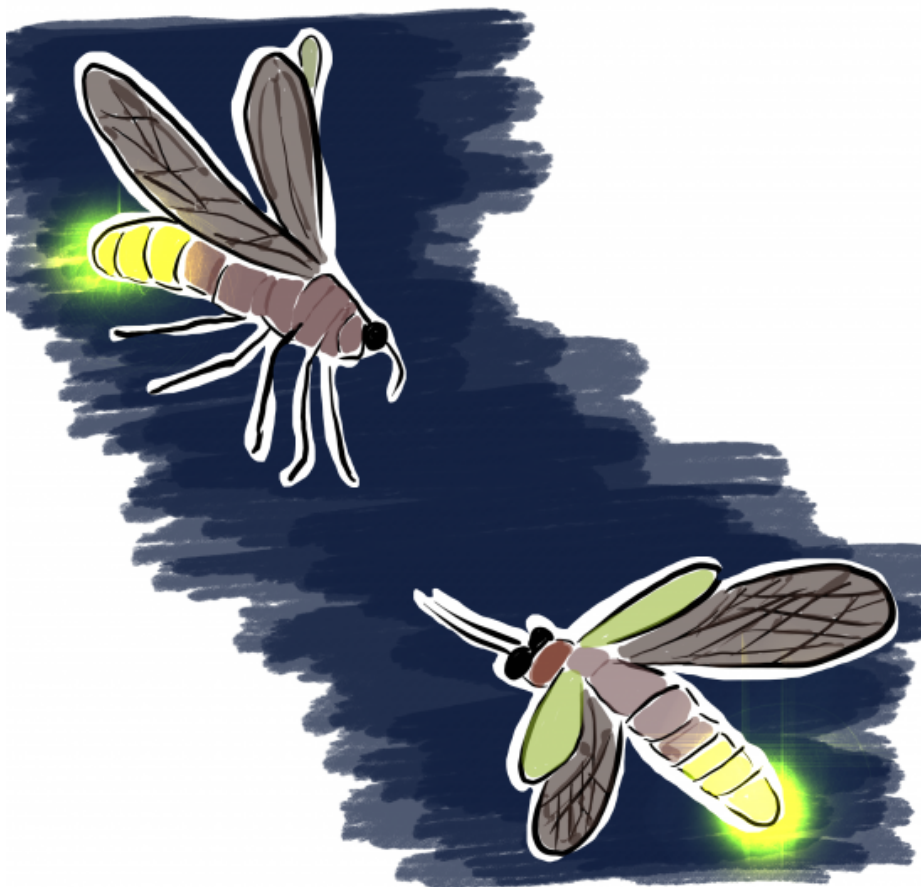


Ukhanyikhanyi uqala impilo yawo uyisibungu, esichanyiselwe eqandeni.
