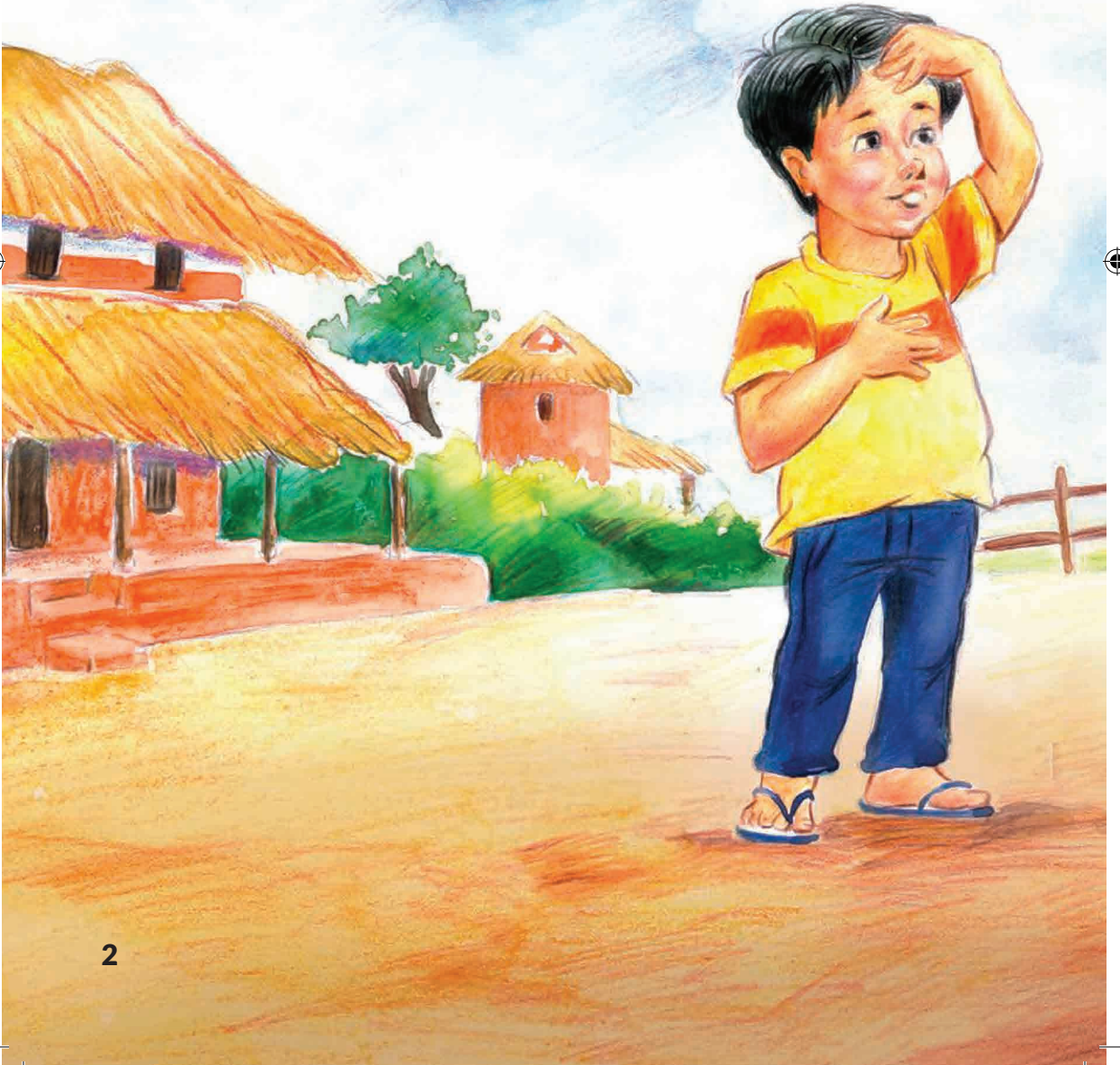

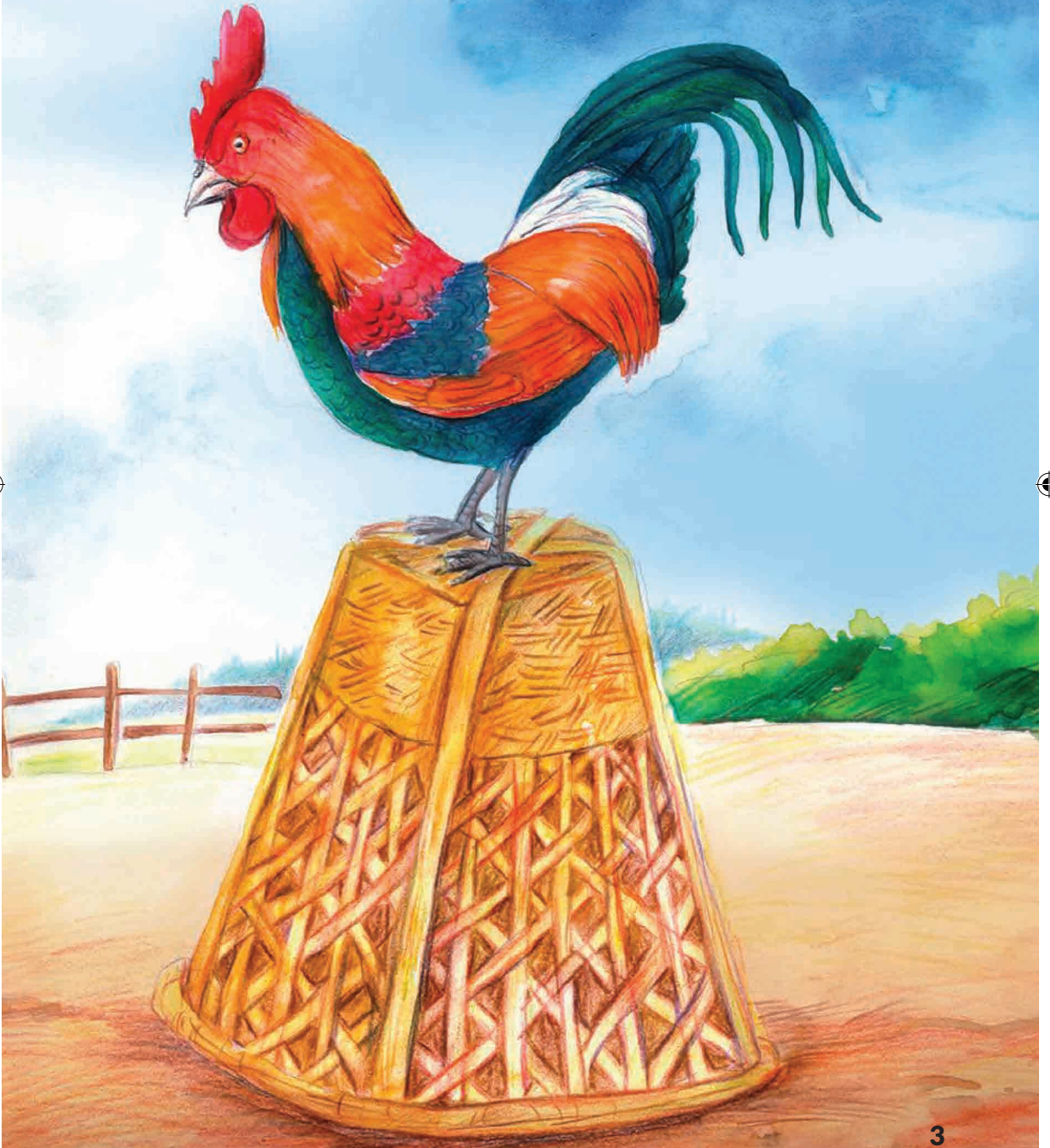

Where is my red crown?

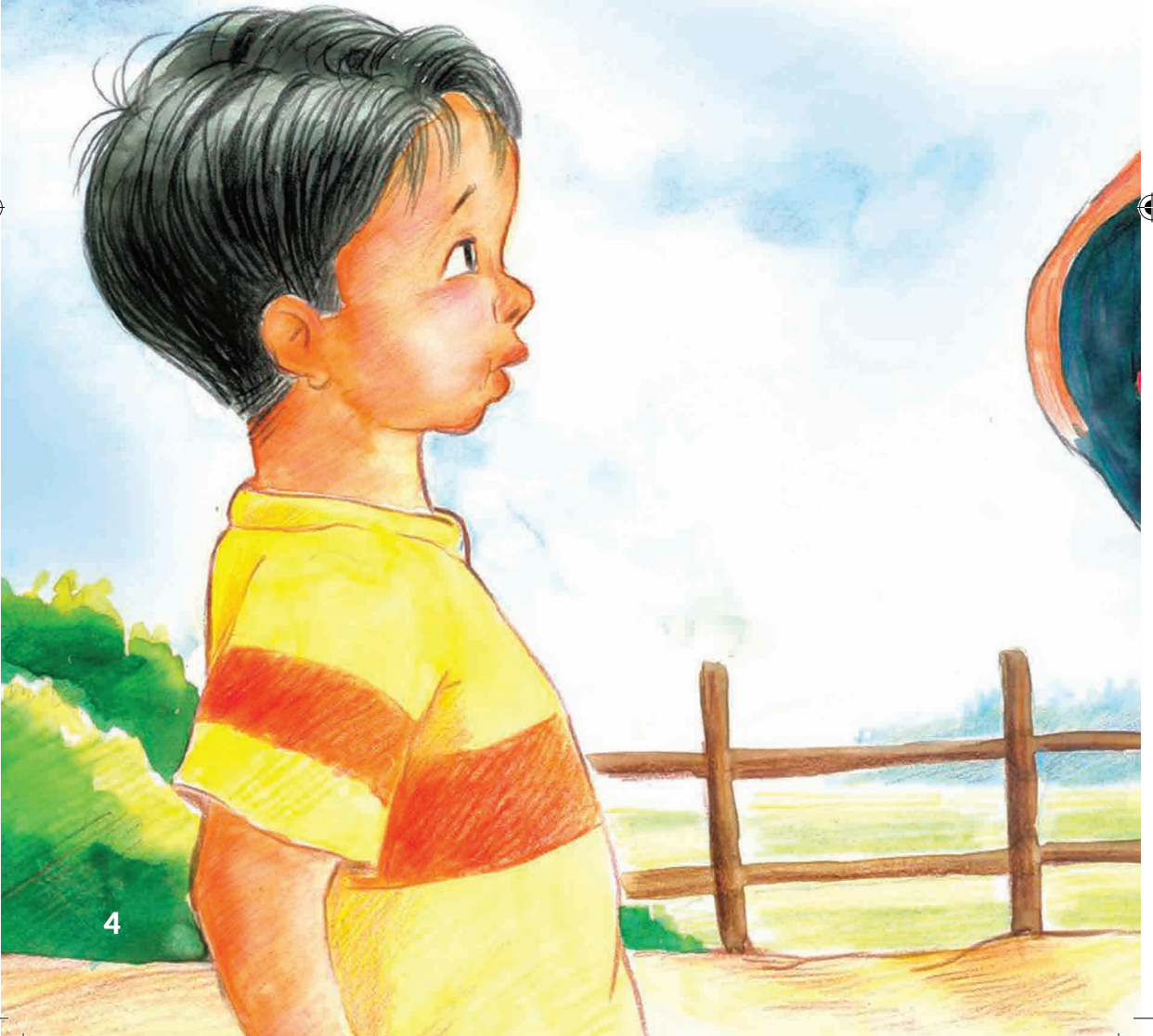








**I asked the rooster for  
his red crown.**

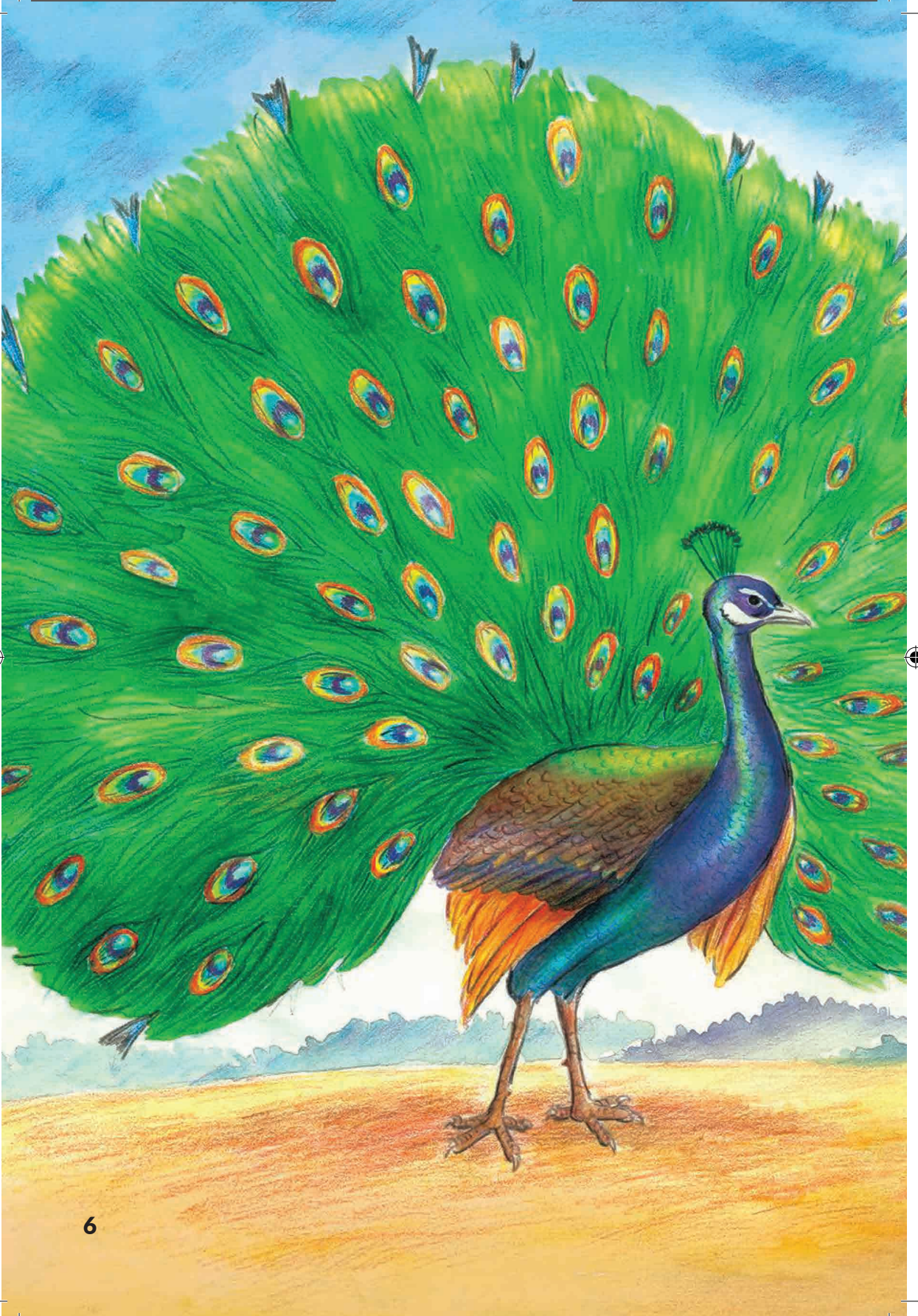




Shaking its head, the red rooster

red crown.”



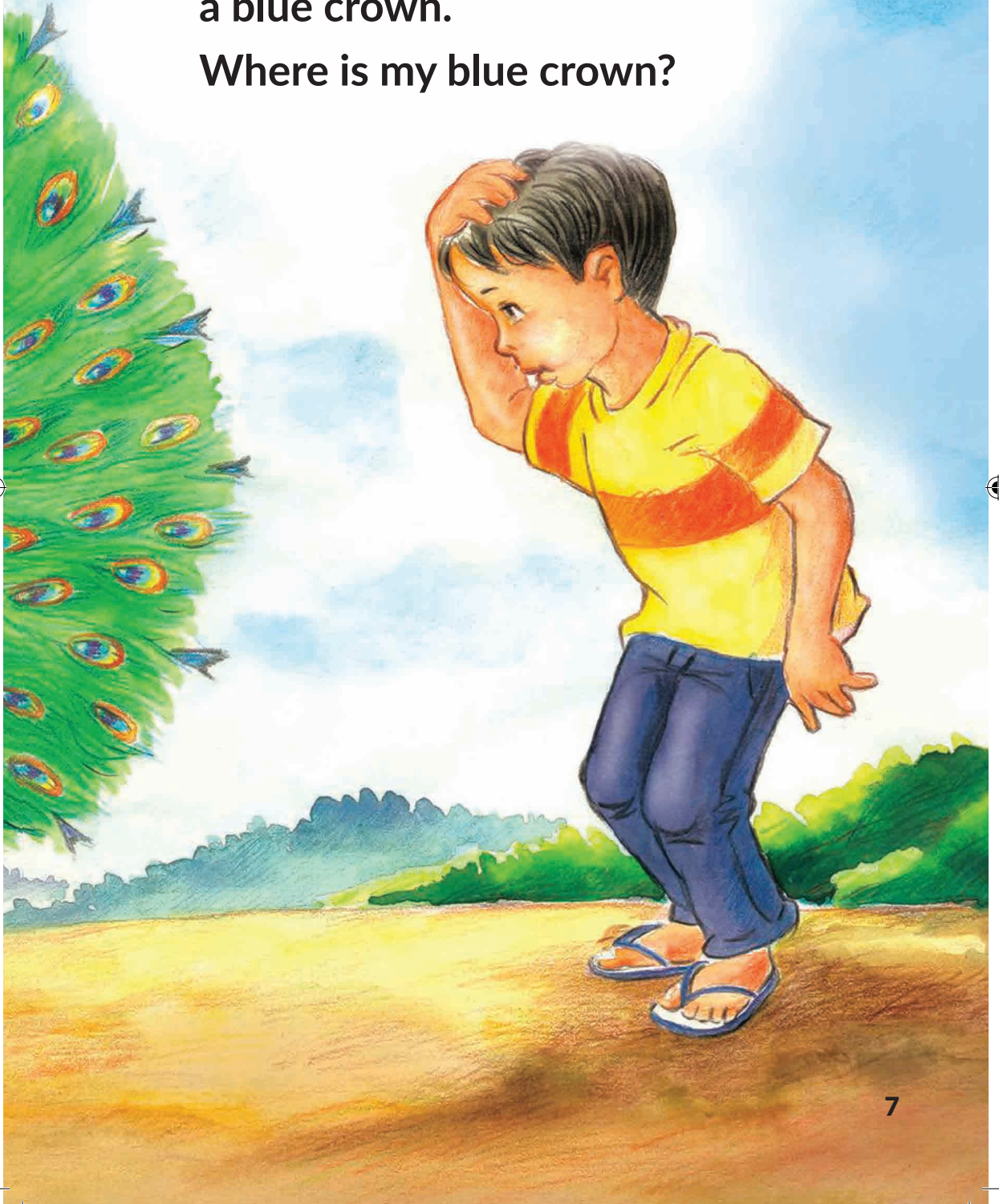






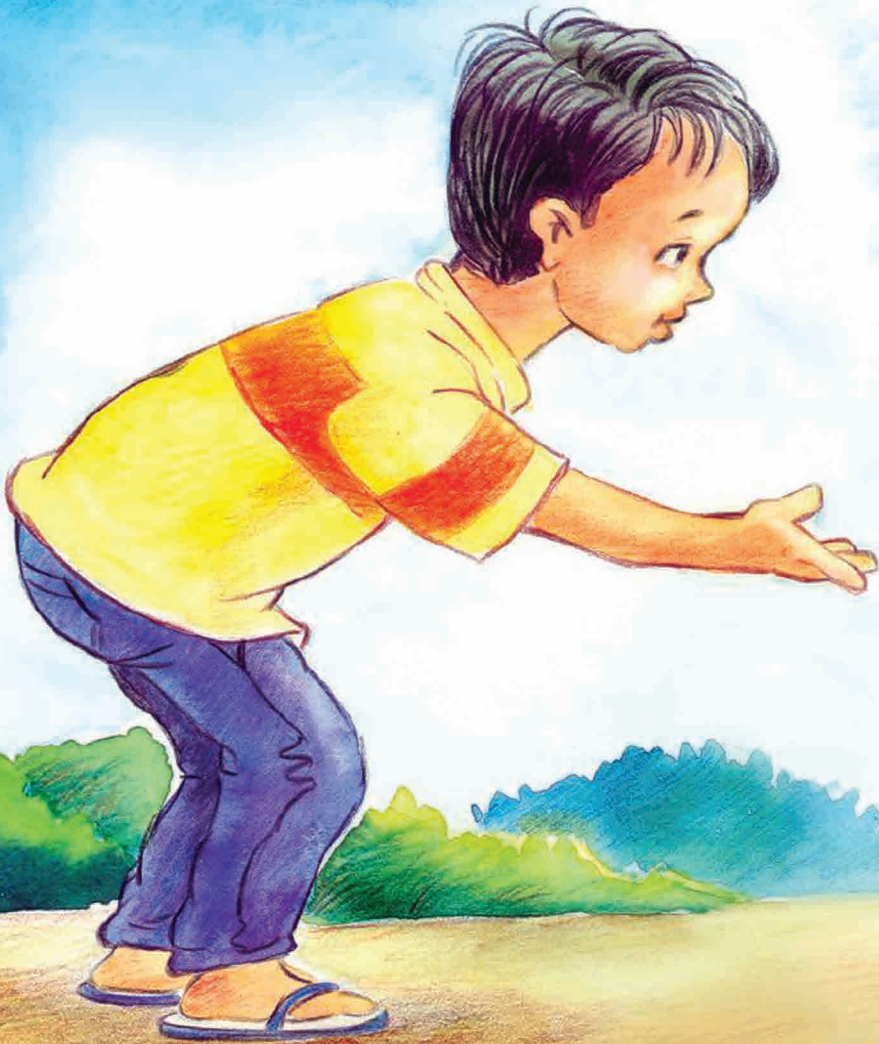


The multi-colored peacock has

crown.”

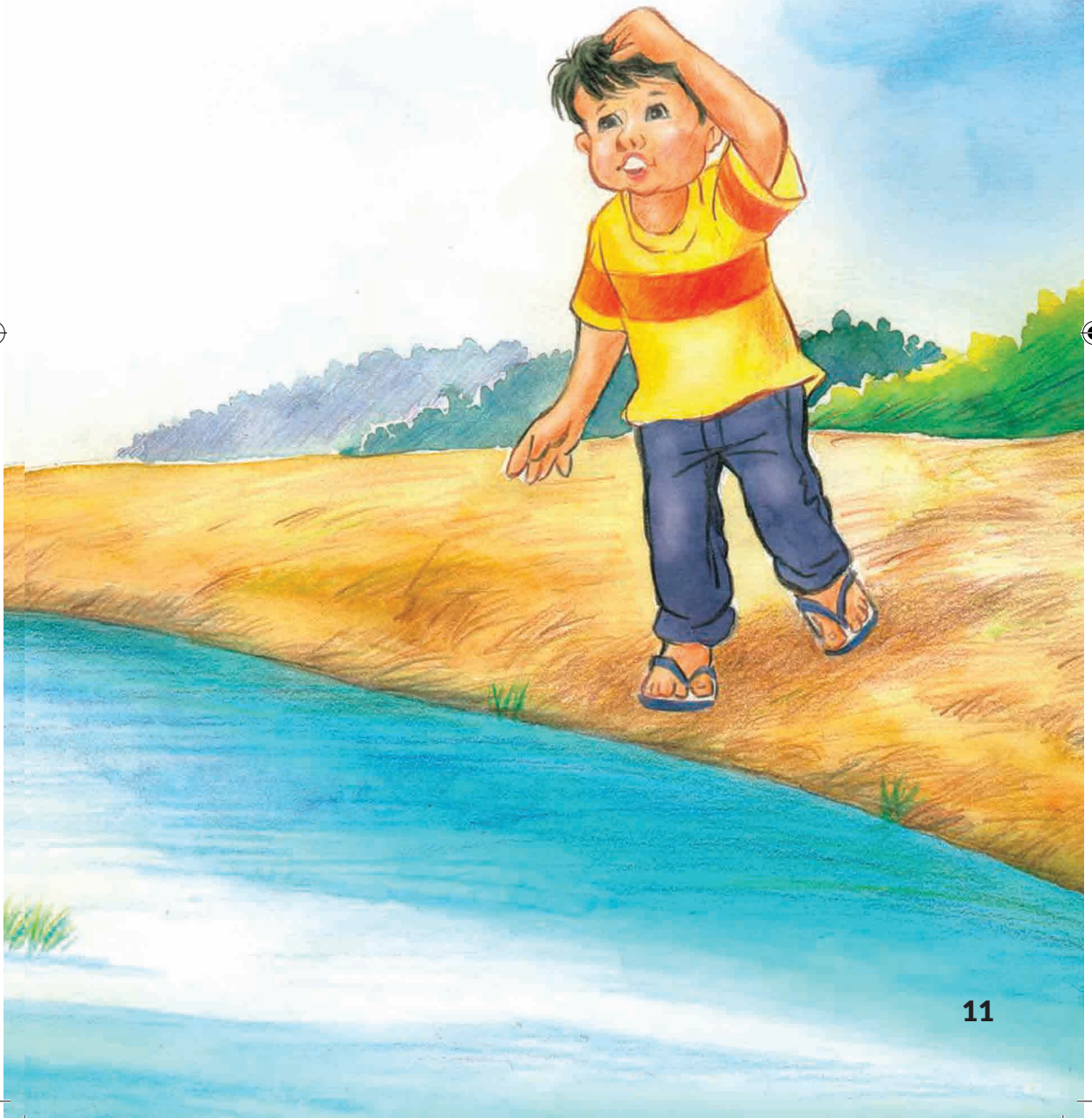






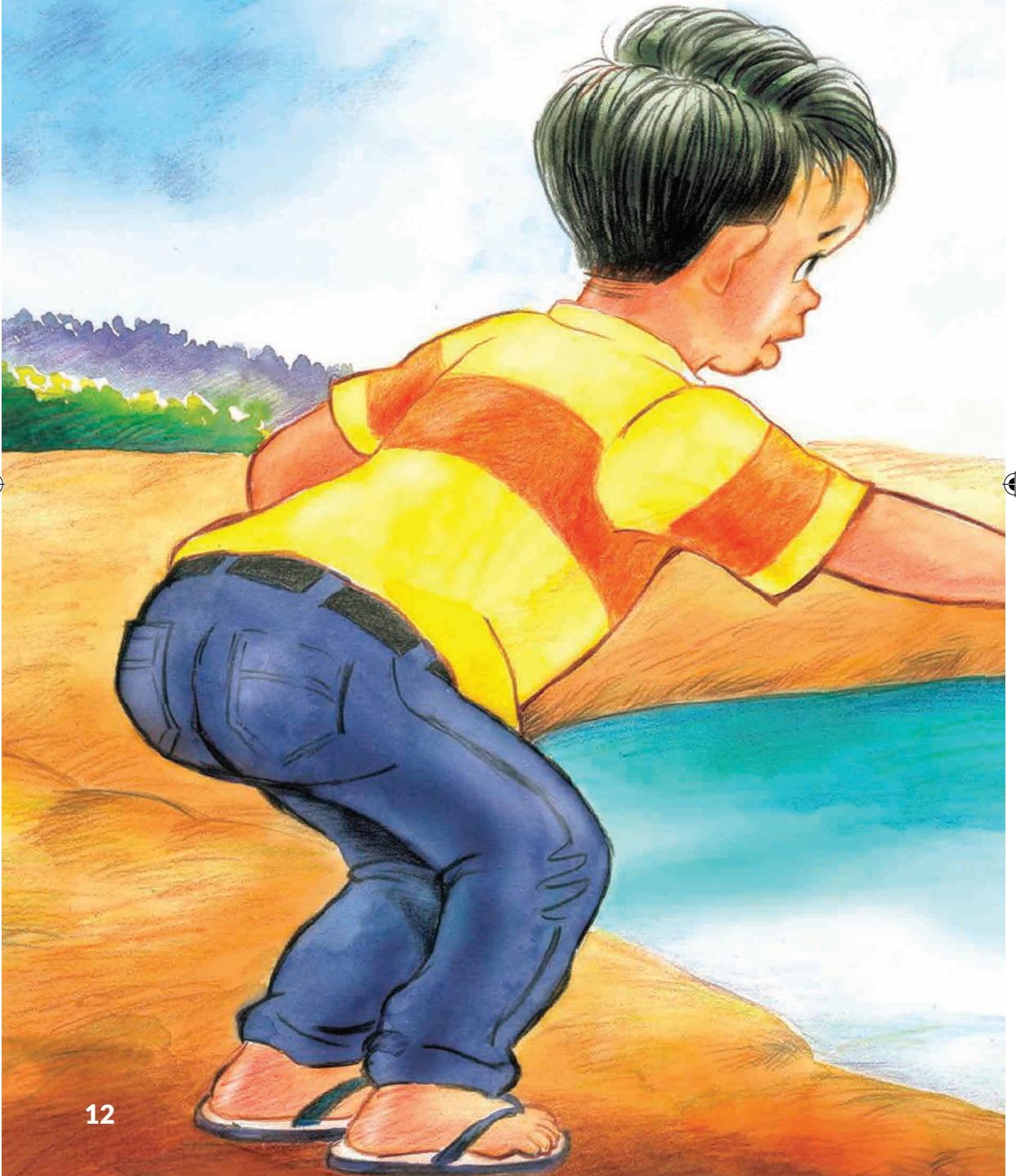


**The white crane has a white crown.  
Where is my white crown?**





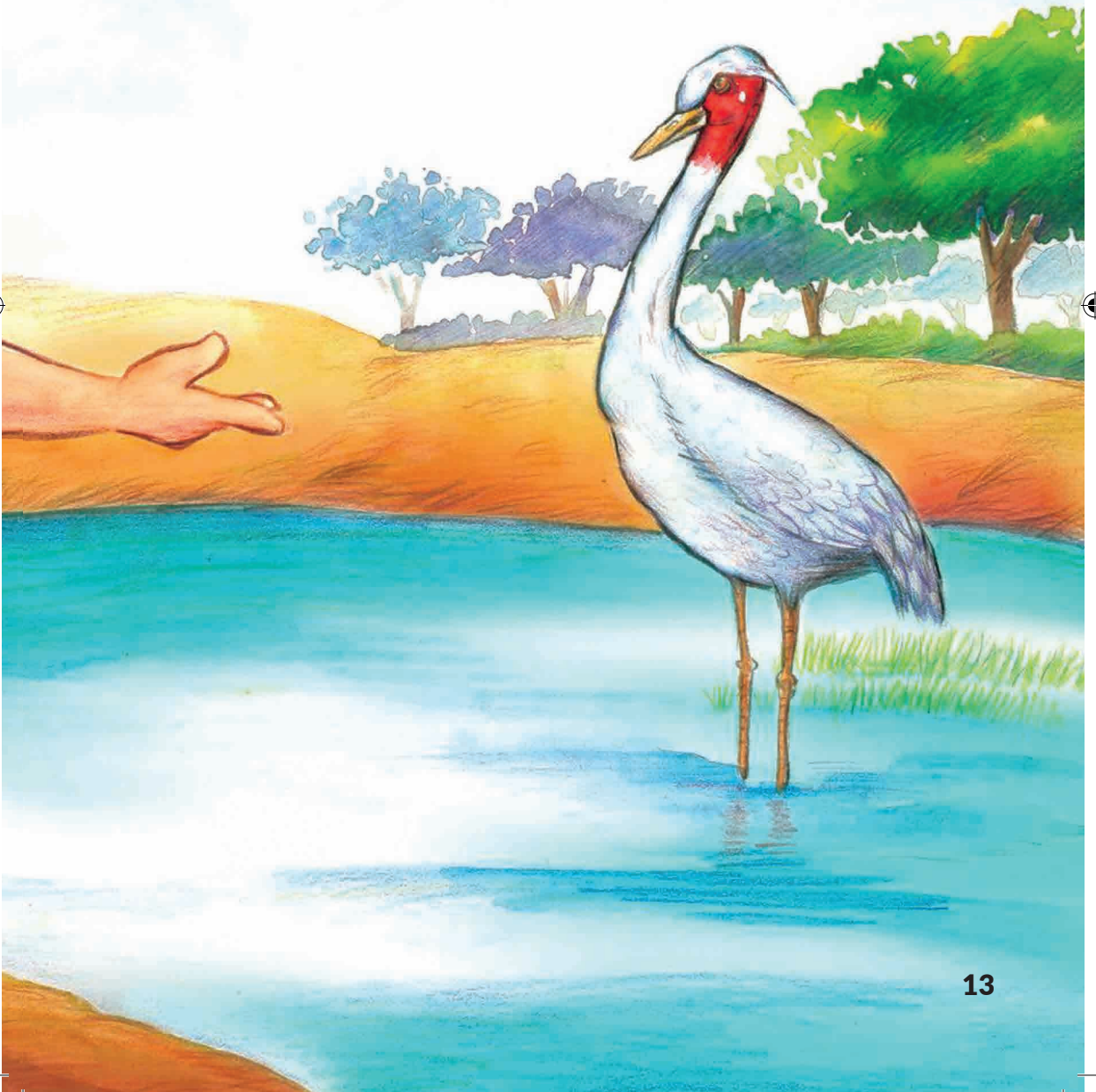
I asked the crane for  
his white crown.





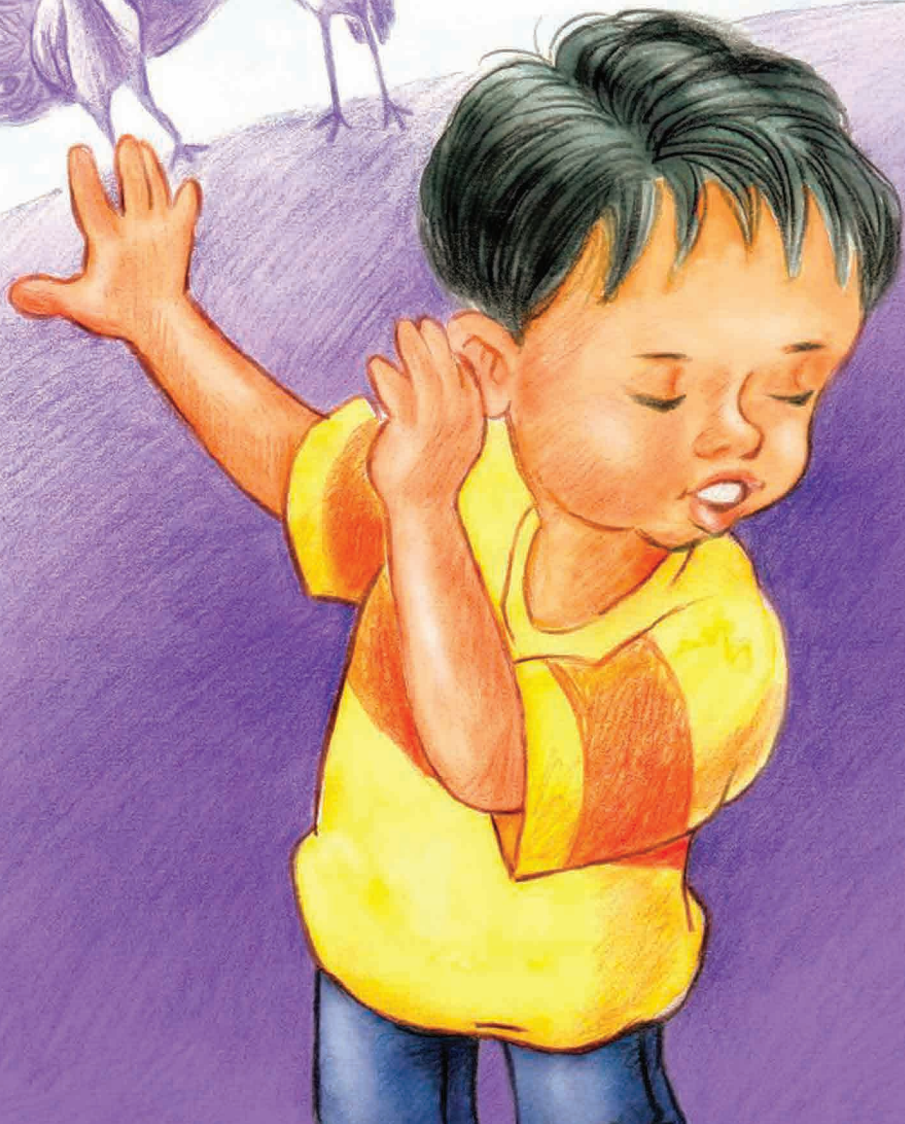
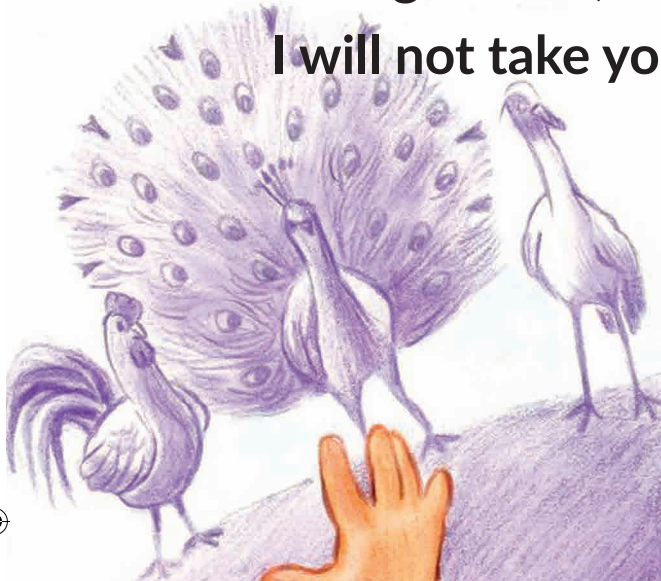


Shaking its head, the crane
