




The red rooster has a red crown.
Where is my red crown?








I asked the rooster for
his red crown.




Shaking its head, the red rooster

his blue crown.




Shaking its head, the peacock said,

crown.”






The white crane has a white crown.
Where is my white crown?







I asked the crane for
