nwaha na nwaha.

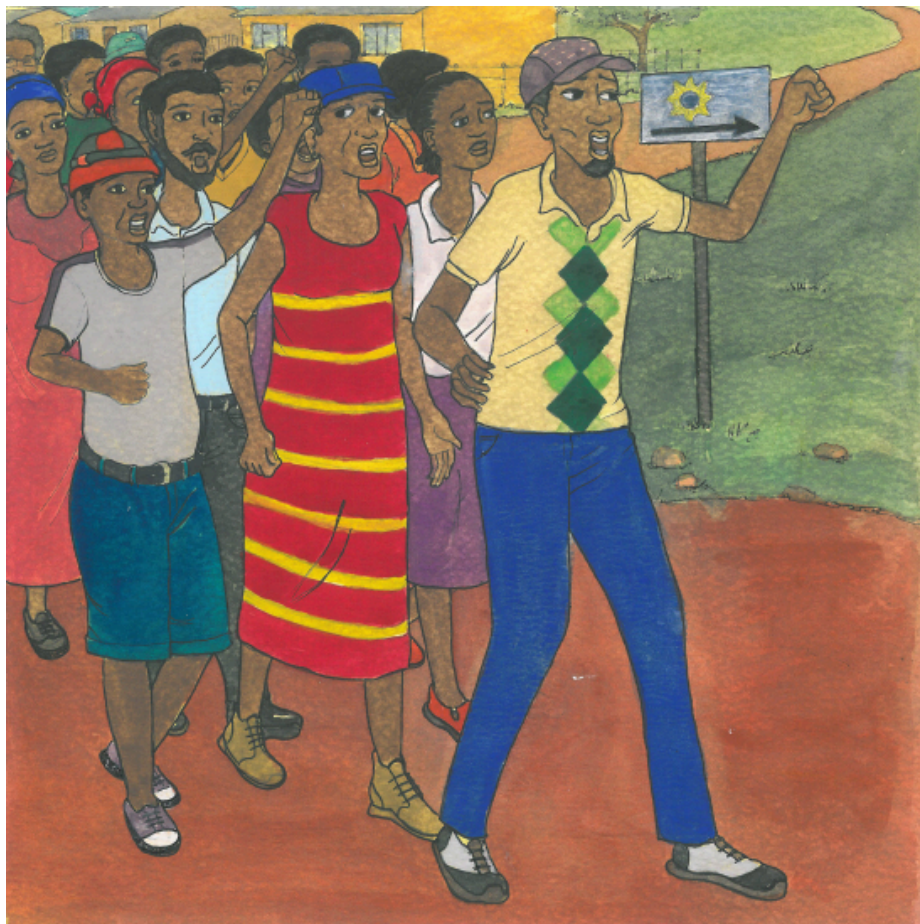
Heyi nganea i malugana na divhazwakale na

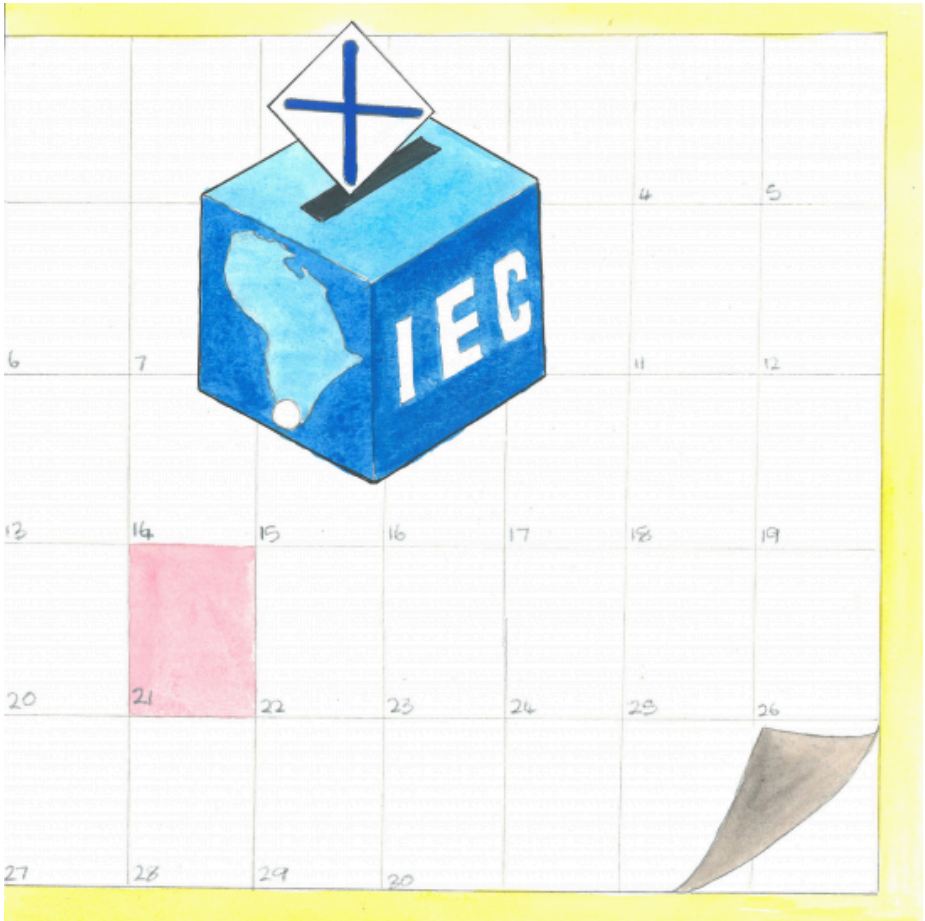
"Amandlaa! Ngawethuu! Maanḁa kha a vhe vhathuni!"

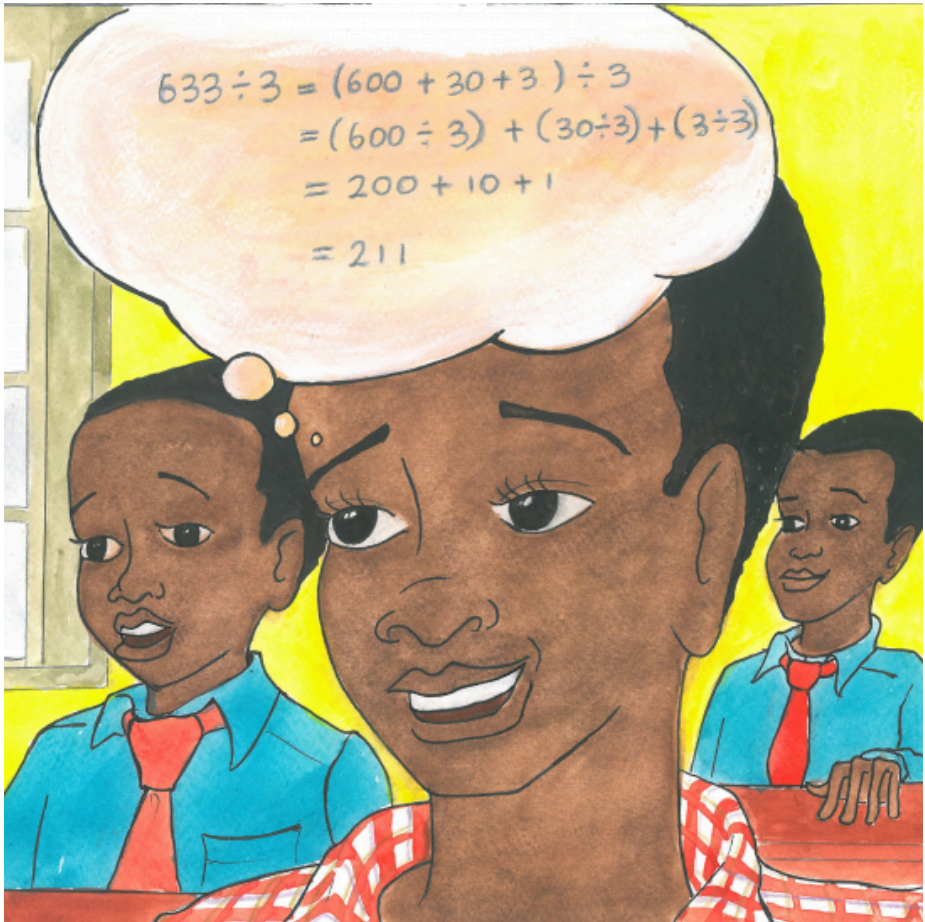


Pfanelo dza vhana vhoṭhe dzi a lingana. Naa ni a ḡivha pfanelo dzaṅu?
