

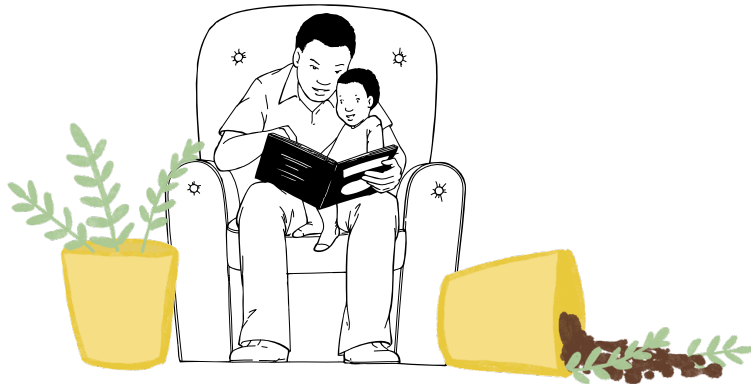


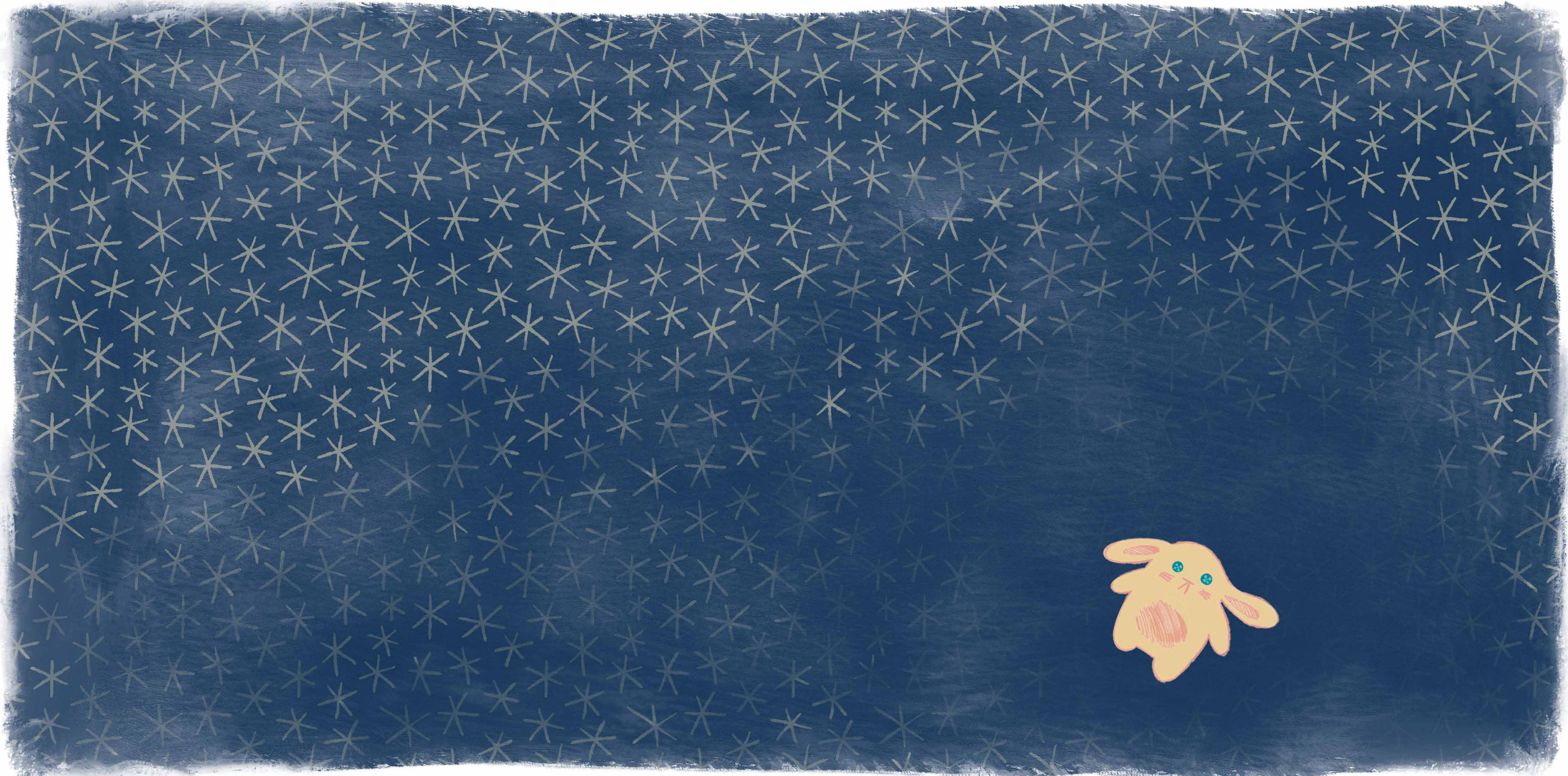

I tried **TRAPPING** it.

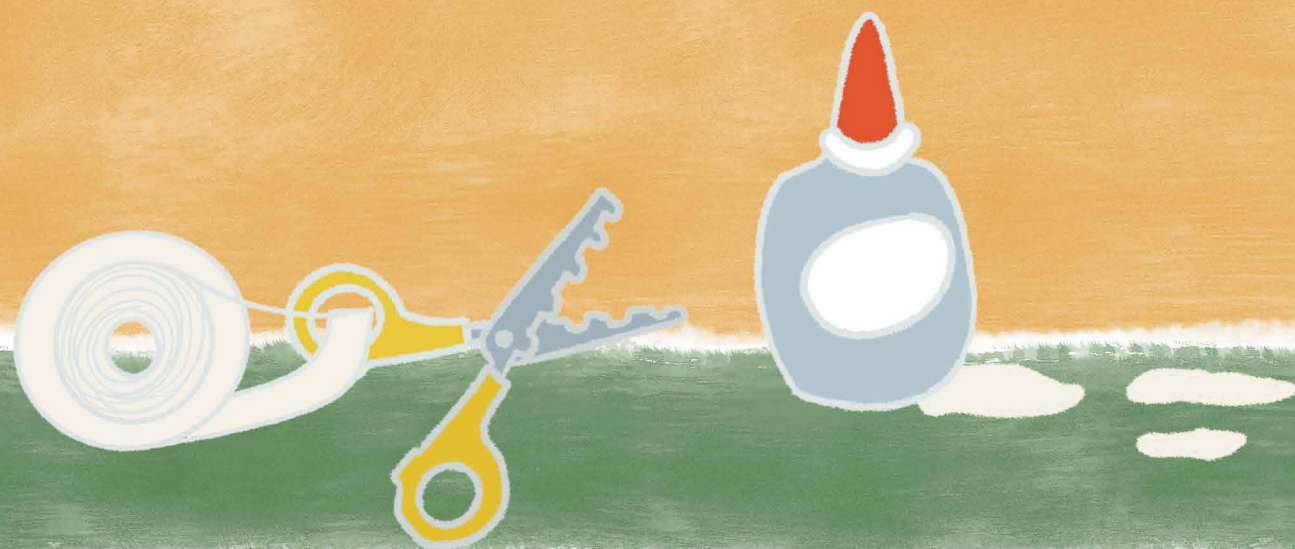


But the monster was
